Update on Renovations at Annunciation

The first task in this project, which began the week of October 15th, was to remove the kneelers and pews from the church and store them in the Parish Center. All of the old kneelers, approximately 190 of them, were taken home by nine different parishioners so none of them ended up in a dump somewhere. When the workers removed the pews, they found a couple interesting items. One was a prayer card asking prayers "for the repose of the soul of Mrs. Margaret Paro who died on June 16th, 1938," which was just a few months after the church had been dedicated on March 21, 1938. The other item was a bulletin from July 31, 1966, which listed six Sunday Masses (6:45 am, 8 am, 9:15 am, 10:30 am, 11:45 am, and 5:30 pm) and three daily Masses (6:30 am, 7:15 am, and 1 pm). After the pews were removed, the old floor was removed and a new subfloor installed in preparation for the new floor. The project also included cleaning the church, including the ceiling and the walls. Except for the ceiling, the initial cleaning did not do much to improve its appearance and so we had the contractor do a more thorough cleaning, particularly of the faux stone, which covers most of the walls, the pillars, and the arches. While the deeper cleaning did make a difference, the committee felt that we should paint the faux stone as well. The initial contract did not include painting the faux stone. The problem is, if we do not paint it now, it will look even worse with everything else freshly painted. It is important to know that the last time the church was painted was 52 years ago. Furthermore, it will be a lot more expensive to do it in the future with the pews in place. So now is the best time to do it. The committee wrestled with the issues of increased cost and a longer period of time for the completion of the project, but in the end, decided that the extra money and extra six weeks will be well worth it when the project is completed. The original completion date was December 15th. That will now be moved to February 1st, which will be in time for a scheduled wedding on February 23rd and Ash Wednesday on March 6th. While we understand you may be disappointed that we will not be able to celebrate the Christmas season at Annunciation, we are certain you will be pleased with the finished product and will be glad that we took advantage of the time to do it now while all the other work is being done. All Masses will continue to take place at Our Lady Queen of Apostles in Frankfort. Finally, I want to thank the members of the Committee who have given so much of their time and attention to the many details of this project: Lisa Alexander, Skip Ames, Deacon Mike Carbone, Cyndi Cardarelli, Gary Greig, Steve Lachacz, Carol Lennon, Fran Reina, Fran Retzloff, Gary Slopka, Bev Tutty, and Dave Williams.

Purgatory

The following are excerpts adapted from an interview with Maria Simma, taken from a booklet entitled: *The Amazing Secret of the Souls in Purgatory*. Maria was from Sonntag, Austria (1915-2004) and reportedly had visitations by the holy souls in purgatory.

What do the holy souls ask of you? In most cases, they ask for Masses and that one be present at these Masses. They ask to have the Rosary said and also that one make the Stations of the Cross.

Maria, do the souls in Purgatory have joy and hope in the midst of their sufferings? Yes. No soul would want to come back from Purgatory to the earth. Their knowledge is infinitely beyond ours. In Purgatory they are certain of living forever with God. Their joy is greater than the pain. There is nothing on earth which could make them want to live here again.

Maria, can you tell us if it is God who sends a soul into Purgatory, or if the soul itself decides to go there? It is the soul itself which wants to go to Purgatory in order to be pure before going to Heaven.

At the moment of death, does one see God in full light or in an obscure manner? In a manner still obscure, but, all the same, in such brightness that this is enough to cause great longing.

Maria, What is the role of Our Lady with the souls in Purgatory? She comes often to console them and to tell them they have done many good things. She encourages them.

Are there any days in particular on which Mary delivers them? Above all, Christmas Day, All Saints Day, Good Friday, the Feast of the Assumption, and the Ascension of Jesus.

Which are the sins which most lead to Purgatory? Sins against charity, against the love of one's neighbor, hardness of heart, hostility, slandering, calumny – all these things. Other sins against charity are all our rejections of certain people we do not like, our refusals to make peace, our refusals to forgive, and all the bitterness we store inside.

Maria, please tell us: who are those who have the greatest chance of going straight to Heaven? Those who have a good heart towards everyone. Love covers a multitude of sins.

What are the means which we can take on earth to avoid Purgatory and go straight to Heaven? We must do a great deal for the souls in Purgatory, for they help us in their turn. We must have much humility. This is the greatest weapon against evil, against the Evil One. Humility drives evil away.

What would you say to a priest who really wants to live according to the Heart of God? I would advise him to pray much to the Holy Spirit – and to say his Rosary every day.
