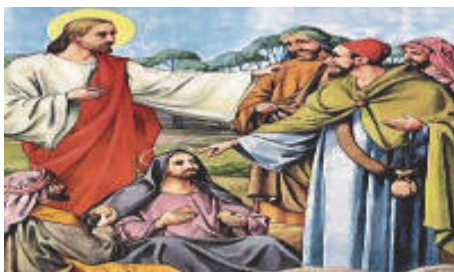

One of the Catholic Charities' longest running programs, Food \$en\$e is a monthly food buying co-op for anyone who wants to stretch their grocery dollars. Food \$en\$e provides a monthly box of 12-15 staple grocery items at a discounted price. **There are no qualifications, no subscriptions, and no requirements to participate in Food \$en\$e. SNAP benefits accepted.**

Each package costs \$20.50 without limitation to the number of packages you may buy. While the items vary from month to month, the package always includes:

4-5 meat items like chicken, ground beef or fish

4-5 staple pantry items like pasta, soup, and rice

2 fresh produce items like apples, carrots or oranges

Dear Family

Most of us know the heart-sinking reality of having a loved one far from God. Having taken the wide road, they travel seemingly with no desire for His Love nor any care for their soul. Despite efforts to pour His Love into them, they remain immersed in the darkness of sin.

We may ask: "How can I help? What can I do?" There are times, no doubt, when there is some work, word, or resource that we can offer. But there are other times when our hands seem tied, our efforts met with angst, and our offer of Christ's love rejected. In this, there is helplessness akin to abandonment. It is our share in Our Lord's Agony in the Garden.

Family, this is how we can help, this is what we can do! Let us make an offering of our helplessness to Jesus, on behalf of those who have strayed. There is a profound fruitfulness to placing them in His Heart, opened by a lance as He hung upon the Cross. In this way, with peace and confidence, we remain with Him.

Family, abandonment, fear, rejection, and discouragement will come. The remedy is the allow these to blend with His Love, and thus to keep yourself and those in darkness "going toward the Light." **KEEP RUNNING TOWARD THE LIGHT!**

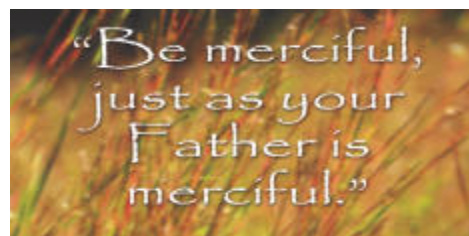
