### **Church Regulations Regarding Fast and Abstinence**

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen years old & older on Ash Wednesday & on all the Fridays of Lent. This obligation prohibits the eating of meat, but not eggs, milk products, or condiments of any kind, even though made from animal fat.

Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal on a given fast day. Catholics who are eighteen years of age but not yet fifty-one are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. On fast days, two additional smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength. However, the two smaller meals together may not equal one full meal. Moreover, eating solid foods between meals on fast days is not permitted.

**Feast day: March 19**

The Church traditionally dedicates the month of March to the special veneration of St. Joseph. Chosen by the eternal Father as guardian and protector of Jesus and Mary, Joseph carried out his vocation as head of the Holy Family with obedience and fidelity to God.

Saint Joseph heard God's invitation to profoundly participate in a mystery he could scarcely comprehend. With sacred astonishment, he accepted the Divine Mystery embodied in his betrothed wife. With humble purity he sought to veil this awesome mystery with his absence. It was then that an angel appeared, issuing God's invitation, to take the Virgin and unborn Christ Child under his roof. Within the silence of his heart, Joseph responded, "Yes".

St. Joseph led with silent strength. **He is the beloved Patron of the universal Church, fathers, the dying and those seeking social justice.**



## St. Patrick

**Feast day: March 17**

St. Patrick was a fifth-century bishop in Ireland known as the "Apostle of Ireland". Captured from his British home at the age of 16 by Irish pirates he lived as a slave herding sheep. At the time, Ireland was a land of Druids and pagans but Patrick turned to God, prayed constantly and grew in faith.

After six years he was able to escape and return to his family in Britain, where he became a cleric. Patrick had a vision prompting him to journey back to Ireland but this time as a Christian missionary. He preached the Gospel and built many churches. Entire kingdoms were eventually converted to Christianity after hearing Patrick's message.
