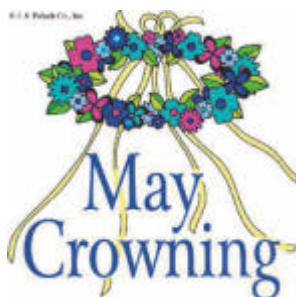

Our Lady of Fatima Novena

May 4-12 (Feast Day: May 13)

Most Holy Virgin, who deigned to come to Fatima to reveal to the three little shepherds the treasures of graces hidden in the recitation of the Rosary, inspire our hearts with a sincere love of this devotion, so that by meditating on the mysteries of our redemption that are recalled in it, we may gather the fruits and obtain the conversion of sinners, the conversion of Russia, and this favor (mention your request), which I so earnestly seek and which I ask of thee in this novena, for the greater Glory of God, for thine own honor, and for the good of all people. Amen.

(Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be – 3 times each.)

What is a Novena?

From the Latin word for “nine,” a novena signifies nine days of public or private prayer with a special intention in mind. The first novena originated with the nine days the disciples and Mary spent in prayer after Jesus ascended into heaven.

Novenas are a wonderful opportunity to reaffirm your faith in a unique and profound way. Each day, devote some quiet to reflect on the meaning of the novena prayer. Study it; think about its message. Repeat the verses with a pure and sincere heart. It’s not necessary to pray at the same time each day, nor to fast or pray the rosary as part of the novena. Of course, you can do these things if you choose.

If you happen to miss a day, don’t worry; simply say the daily prayers twice in one day to catch up. It’s the significance of praying with a heart open to God’s will that allows the novena to have its full effect. God knows what’s best for us, and we need to trust in His divine intention. All prayers should be completed with the Sign of the Cross and the words, “Thy will be done.”
