Blessed are They That Mourn



Our Lord said, *“Blessed are they that mourn for they shall be comforted.”*

The word “mourning” is usually associated with the death of a loved one. When we mourn a beloved’s death, we do so with a deep awareness of personal loss, pain and separation. As Christians, however, we also mourn with the firm hope of our ultimate reunion, in Heaven. This hope anchors our grief in God, and opens our hearts to His comfort.

Mother Angelica, however, invites us to consider the beatitude “Blessed are they that mourn...” not so much from the perspective of mourning bodily death, but of **mourning the spiritual wound or death that comes by way of sin. She links this beatitude to the grace and virtue of repentance.** As we mourn our sins, we do so with a keen awareness of how our sins have affected our relationship with God and brought separation, loss and pain to ourselves and others.

Just as hope anchors grief over bodily death in God, so does mercy in the spiritual realm. **By mourning for our sins, we open our broken hearts to receive God’s mercy more deeply, and as an antidote to spiritual death.** On the other hand, mourning our sins without an awareness of mercy can lead to discouragement and even despair. But with mercy, repentance breathes life where once death reigned.

Mother Angelica even offers us a strategy to live this beatitude in our daily life:

- ◆ **Be truly sorry for our sins**
- ◆ **Occasionally do a review of our life with an eye on God’s mercy**
- ◆ **Realize that even though we may have loved God too little, it is never too late**
- ◆ **Acknowledge our sins for what they are, and accept daily crosses as a means of reparation**
- ◆ **Stay away from the near occasions of sin**

Let us take this beatitude to heart and practice Mother’s simple advice. Doing so, we will enjoy the comfort of God.

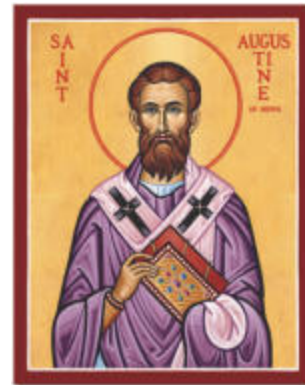
