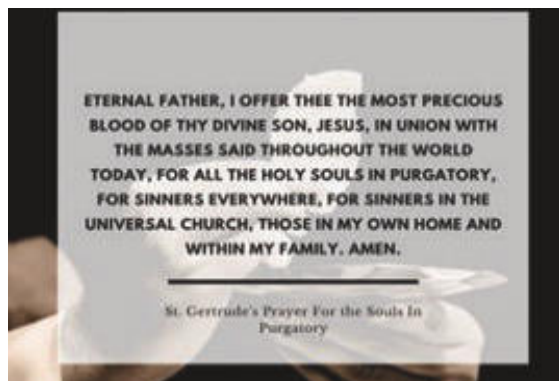

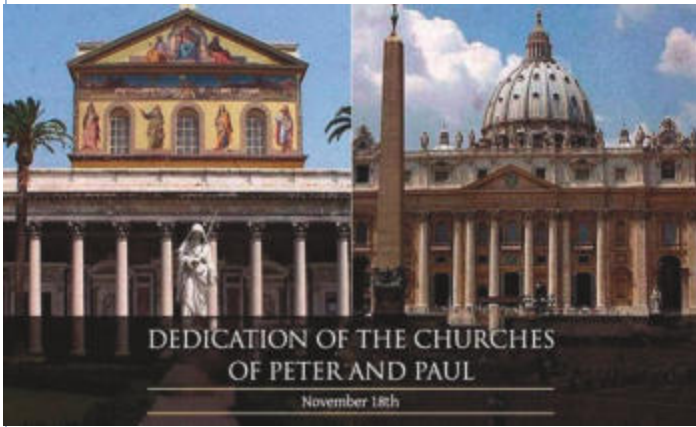

Christmas Mass Schedule

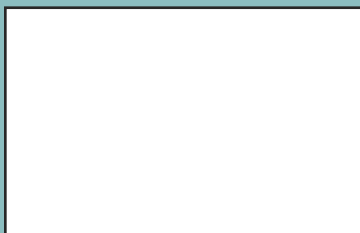
